In 1962, well before Vietnam, UN study (Eco. & Social Consequences of Disarmament) concluded \$120 bln. spent annually on military, somewhere bet. 8 & 9% of world's output of all goods "services" from 2/3rds and some say total nat. income of all backward country. In US it was 9.8% (1957-9 as average)
