The machine was the proof not mexely of the miterial prodiction which is now posaible sans capitalista but, in the opnoretie is itaelf but a forin of dead labor oppresaing living labor. He ginply did not go 11 for blusprints guch gs Mursuse is trying to go into regaraing whether automation oan be or cannot be fully realizable under captalism. Onf thing however, he never Vail ed froin and that was that no machine, no "thing", nazthor automated or otherwise, can dis copitalism's grave; only living being oph, only those strateglically gituatea in produoction can be decibive in that grave-digging.

You aeem to think that the movement from/concrete analysis would be more fruitful thsn workins on philosophy. concrete analyaes are always useful, and can never be stopped--no dielectician was ever a greater eaplicioal wan than Marx (or for that matter Hegel ingofar as history was concrned) on both eoonomics and bistory, I worked on "the" analysis of TNEC, etc.etc. for years on and, but then daciced that at this atege they do not ohange matterg fundamentally whereas pliliosophy can throw new and profound illuminations stili. (Incidentaily, I did retian to economicg in my xiv for the ingue of Nids whioh is coming off the press now, but it had to be removed because of Khrushohev's fall and China's atomic explosion, so it will first appear in next isoue.)

How the raason for this attachment to philosophy, or, more spealifically and only Hegelian philosophy and marxian humaniem, is that, in this ephere, abstraction is a help because it is not abatraction from reality but a generalization based on reality whoae logic Feveals 2180 the puil of the futurg.
