Of course, through the years, I have followed your works. <u>Islam and Cavitalism</u> interested me especially because of its so-profound analysis of Marx's <u>Crundrisse</u> that there were parts which led me to think that you might also have been acquainted with <u>Marx's Ethnological Notebooks</u>. It is the latter which has preoccubied me in recent years and resulted in my challenge to all post-Marx Marxists, beginning with Engels, this Marx centenary.
