Dear Comrades,

In reference to your request of Dec. 14 that "branches be notified in advance of upcoming bulletins in a literary discussion on special areas of work so that contributions from the branches can be made."

According to the Boston branch minutes of Dec. 13, where the motion to send this request was passed, the request was made in relation to the announcement of Internal Information Bulletin #7, 1969 on women's liberation.

At the convention panel on women's liberation the report by Mary Alice Waters concludes, stating, "Rather than transcribe and distribute all the reports given at the panel, which have already been outdated by new developments this fall, the national office plans to send out reports of interest on women's liberation activities as they are sent in."

Bulletin #7 includes comrade Waters' report to the panel and the first informational reports we have received since then. It is anticipated that other informational reports on women's liberation will be published as information is received in the national office from the branches.

As you will note from a national office communication dated Dec. 11, the Political Committee has set the dates Dec. 15-Feb. 15 for the post-convention literary discussion on the issues raised in the convention political resolution and report. Contributions to this literary discussion are open for all comrades.
