Dear Comrades:

After intensive study of the tactical and technical factors involved in nominating a party presidential ticket, the Political Committee has adopted the following motion: "To poll the National Committee on a recommendation to nominate Fred Halstead for president and Paul Boutelle for vice president, the N.C. nominations to remain subject to ratification by the party convention."

For tactical reasons public announcement of the N.C. nominations should be postponed until about Labor Day. During the interim it is important that the subject be treated as a strictly internal party matter.
