Dear Comrade,


For your information we are enclosing a copy of the minutes of the "second session" of the "unity negotiations" between the Robertsonite Spartacist outfit and the Wohlforthite American Committee of the Fourth International.

These "negotiations" were undertaken under the prodding of Healy and Co. and have apparently been going on for some time. The present state of the "negotiations" is somewhat obscure. Although both groups published the Healy resolution on "unity" there has, as yet, been no public announcement of the projected "fusion." As indicated by the minutes the regroupment approach to Progressive Labor turned sour. The unfolding drama could well be entitled: Political Parasites in Search of a Host.

Also enclosed is a report from our Twin Cities comrades on the recent constitution of an ACFI group in that area, composed of ex's of one kind and another. You had been previously informed that Henry Schultz had met with Healy in Montreal last fall. The Minneapolis-St. Paul Healy group is the ripe fruit that grew out of that tryst.

We will keep you informed of the further unfolding of Healy's "unity offensive." We count on you to do likewise.
