Dear Comrades,

Jean Pierre Beauvais, a leader of the JCR, will be making a North American speaking tour during the month of August.

This tour is being arranged jointly between the YSA and the YS/LJS in Canada in order to get a first hand account by a student leader of what has happened in France and to raise money for the defense of the French workers and students.

Because of the short amount of time Jean Pierre will spend in the U.S. it will not be possible for him to speak in every area.

In organizing the proposed tour schedule we had to select those areas where the biggest meetings could be arranged and where the possibilities for raising money were the best. We came up with the proposed schedule which is attached. Those locals which are included in the schedule should contact us immediately by phone if there are any changes which must be made.

In all publicity and public meetings the name Jean Dubé should be used. Jean Pierre can be advertised as a leader of the JCR, a student of Economics at the University of Paris and as a student activist and leader during the months of May and June in France.

Locals should be prepared to take collections at meetings and to try to raise money in other ways since one of the major purposes of the tour is to help the defense effort.

Tour quotas should be sent to the YSA National Office and not given to Jean Pierre.

This tour will be another important step in identifying the YSA with the young revolutionaries in France.
