
Declaration to the Central Executive Committee of the Communist Party of America, Section of the Communist International.

COMRADES:—

We, the Central Bureau of the Lithuanian Federation of the faction led by the minority of the CEC, in session, June 21, 1922, unanimously decided to immediately comply with the decision of the EC of the CI on the question of the American communist movement, which instructs us to return into the recognized Communist Party and therefore we turn over to the CEC all documents, connections, and property of our federation, and, further,

We ourselves go back to the recognized Communist Party and urge all our comrades to do likewise and to loyally carry on their communist duties.
