NEW YORK, Nov. 20.—A protest demonstration against the imprisonment of Boris Gitlow is being arranged by the International Labor Defense, New York section on Tuesday, November 24, at Webster Hall, 119 East 11th St., at 8 p. m.

Comrade Gitlow is sentenced to a term of from 5 to 10 years for a violation of the New York original criminal law in the case of Judge Weeks in New York City, January, 1935. This verdict was later upheld by state supreme court and finally by the United States supreme court.

The International Labor Defense is conducting a campaign for the release of Comrade Gitlow. A resolution is now being sent out to unions in New York City for their adoption, by the International Labor Defense, showing up the nature of the persecution and calling for its immediate reversal.

The International Labor Defense has called upon all workers' organizations to join in this protest meeting.
