3. A five-day week of forty hours, and a twelve-day week of 48 hours, to be worked for the same wage as for the present week of 40 hours.

4. All amendments introduced by a delegate at a meeting for a referendum of the membership.
5. Job control so that the "hire-and-fire" system.

The Officers are elected by local union delegates to the D. C. Council.
