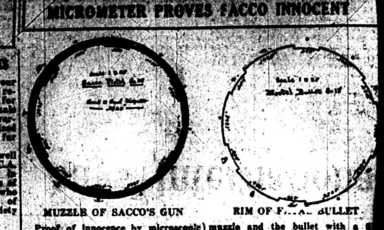

The Irish Elections

The surprise of the Irish elections was the large vote polled by the Republican Party despite the fact that 18,000 of their most active workers are in jail. The subject of the elections was the Free State government. Judge Coghlan, of New York, was imported to Ireland to campaign against the republicans and particularly against De Valera. The latter was arrested on the day of the elections and the result was a landslide headed by the party in Clare and defeated Eoin Mac Neil, the Free State leader. The Republicans returned 44 candidates against 63 for the Free State Party.

When Greek Meets Greek

The Italo-Greek imbroglio will probably be settled without further bloodshed. However, it is not the first time that a mere skirmish has precipitated whole nations into an exterminating war. The Balkans, in fact, seem to possess the proper atmosphere for war incipientness. Therefore, anything is possible that comes from this troublesome region.

Muzzler of Sacco's Gun

Proof of innocence by microscopic examination of pistol bullets will be offered in an argument for a new trial for Nicola Sacco and Bartolomeo Vanzetti, convicted Italian-American radicals, now in the hands of Judge Webster Thayer in the Federal Court at Dedham, Mass. They were the trial judges when a jury found the men guilty of a performance murder in a Boston factory yesterday in a public building. The trial was held in the wake of hysteria against radicals whipped up by the Wilson administration.

When Cases Go Bankrupt

NEW ORLEANS—The wharf of the open shippers is again being harassed by a complaint that the police raiders are finding offenders instead of cases. The police are being urged to quit their fines out on the streets. The finances of the city are in desperate condition, the revenues from taxes being mortgaged for the next few years, and in some instances longer. Hence it is necessary that raiders do the work required, but they instead of going out with families to support and pay decent wages.

Associated Press Says Trotsky

Soviet leaders live a deathly life. For the 64th time, as we see by an Associated Press dispatch from Moscow, Leon Trotsky has just been arrested by the Russian police. He is being held in a cell, decapitated or burned. These happened all the way from Riga, but in Moscow itself. They occurred in special cables, particular wireleses, and selected portions of ordinary news.

It would appear that Sir Basil Zerkoff, the Greek millionaire, has a good sized equity in that stormy peninsula.
