

FRENCH REVOLUTION THREATENS WHILE PEACE CONFERENCE TAKES.

(International Labor News Service) PARIS.—Economic conditions in France have not improved since the signing of the armistice. The people are suffering intensely, with no means of relief in sight.

The food situation has become more demoralizing. There are no more additional allowances upon case they have families dependent upon them. The soldiers' wages are, however, wholly inadequate to support their families. Many factories are still turning out munitions because of government orders. The condition of the people is not in any adequate way. The wages received under these circumstances are being paid with money—hardly and without French currency. The American soldiers are free to take back the American money. The price of other things has also correspondingly high.
